Acts 20:22-28 NRSV	
<sup>22</sup> And now, as a captive to the Spirit, I am on my way to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there, <sup>23</sup> except	

that the Holy Spirit testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and persecutions are waiting for me. <sup>24</sup> But I do not count my life of any value to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the good news of God's grace. <sup>25</sup> "And now I know that none of you, among whom I have gone about proclaiming the kingdom, will ever see my face again. <sup>26</sup> Therefore I declare to you this day that I am not responsible for the blood of any of you, <sup>27</sup> for I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God. <sup>28</sup> Keep watch over yourselves and over all the flock, of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God that he obtained with the blood of his own Son.
